

The Estelline City Council held a special meeting on Wednesday, November 18, 2015 in the City Council Chambers. Those present included Mayor Zafft, Julie Rieckman, Paul Setnes, Wayne Wegner, Ryan Miller, Mike Gunderson, Chris Lilla, Mary Saathoff, Sheriff Chad Schlotterbeck, and LeeAnne Dufek. Mayor Zafft called the meeting to order at 6:00 PM.

The resignation of Jean Sonnenburg as deputy police was presented. A motion was made by P. Setnes, second by J. Rieckman to accept her resignation. With all voting aye, motion carried.

A motion was made by C. Lilla, second by P. Setnes to terminate the Estelline Police Department due to the resignation of Marlyn Pomrenke as police chief in August. With C. Lilla, P. Setnes, J. Rieckman, M. Gunderson and R. Miller voting aye and W. Wegner voting nay, motion carried.

The proposed contract with the Hamlin County Sheriff's Department was discussed. Motion was made by J. Rieckman, second by C. Lilla to contract for 40 hours per week at the rate of \$29.00/hour and to include the DARE Program at the Estelline School District. With C. Lilla, P. Setnes, J. Rieckman, M. Gunderson and R. Miller voting aye and W. Wegner voting nay, motion carried.

A motion was made by P. Setnes, second by J. Rieckman to surplus the 2008 Dodge Durango and offer it for sale to the Hamlin County Sheriff's Department. With C. Lilla, P. Setnes, J. Rieckman, M. Gunderson and R. Miller voting aye and W. Wegner voting nay, motion carried.

With there being no further business, motion to adjourn at 6:35 PM was made by W. Wegner, second by M. Gunderson. With all voting aye, motion carried.
